#### ***Location: YWCA Cortland on January 19 and Virtual in April***

We continue participation in 2026 in YWCA USA's national Until Justice Just Is (UJJI) initiative. We plan to include the 21-day Racial Justice Challenge (RJC) for the fifth year, with virtual learning activities presented each weekday for four weeks (likely in April).
